200th Anniversary of the David Thompson's Arrival in Astoria

On July 15th, 1811 explorer, trapper, map maker and surveyor David Thompson arrived at the Astoria settlement and fur trading outpost. On July 15th 2011, reenactors - including two descendants of Thompson, arrived in Astoria at the end of their journey along the entirety of the Columbia River.

One Chair Limit and Skirt were in Astoria Friday to welcome the David Thompson Brigade with a ceremonial salute and to welcome the weary travelers at the end of their journey. In spite of the Oregon Liquid Sunshine (rain), the event was well attended and a lot of fun. The Oregon Professional Surveyors were there with both modern and period equipment to show how Thompson surveyed and mapped the mighty Columbia.

The Thompson Brigade is just one of the many events that are taking place in celebration of Astoria's 200th birthday. The events culminate this fall with a week-long fur trade encampment at Ft.
